


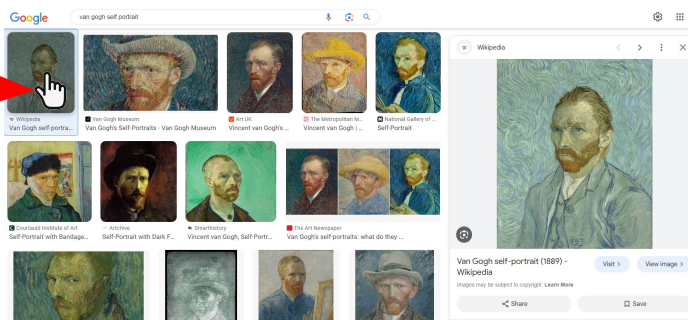
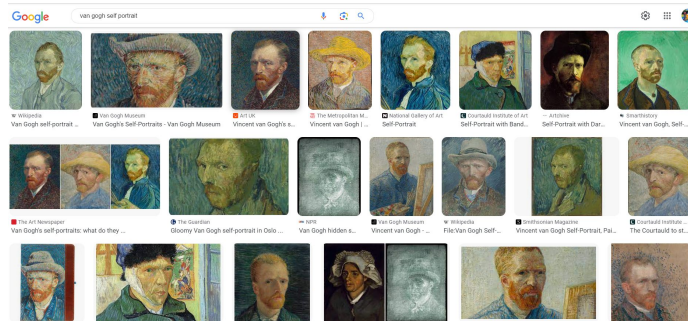
# Saving an Image to USB Drive

## 1. Choosing the image you want to save.

1a Search for the topic you want.

1b Click on 'images'

1c  Left click on the image you want. It will pop up to the right of the images.



1d Size

Hover your mouse over the image and it will show you how big the image is.

### Size does matter!

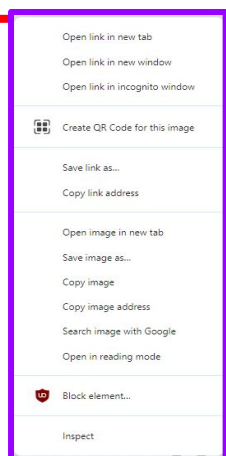
Small images lose detail. Make sure it is a large enough version. If you are going to project it onto a screen, it should be **at least 1400 pixels either wide or high**. If the image is very big you will lose nothing by reducing its size when you use it.



## 2. Save your image

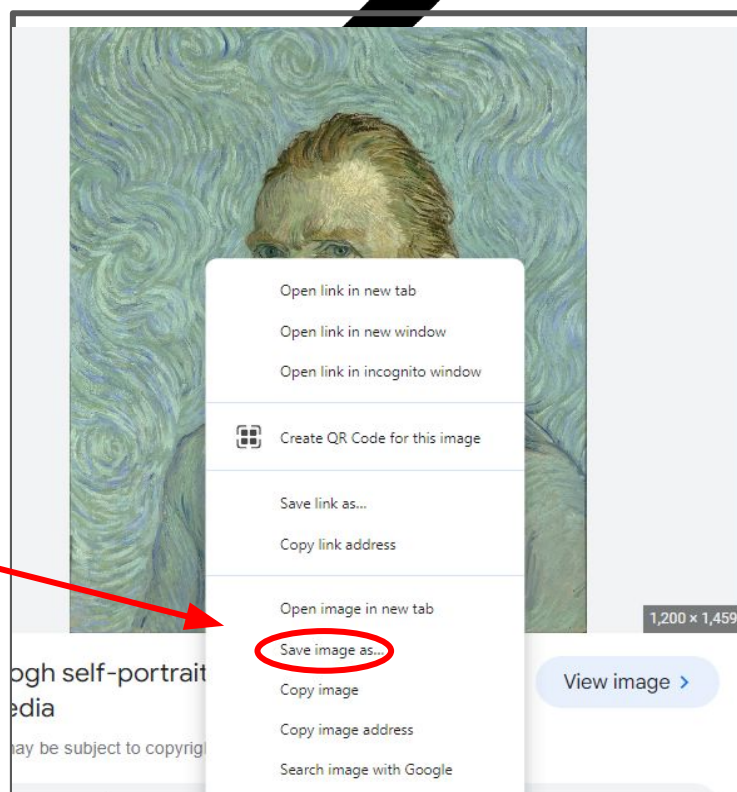
2a Right click on the image. A dialogue box will open.

2b Choose "Save image as..." (or similar wording).

Now you can choose where you will save the image. Name it so you can find it again.



**2c To save the image in the place you want**

Keep hitting this button until you see the folder called Windows (D:) or whatever your memory stick is called. You can save it straight to the memory stick, or if you have folders within the memory stick, keep left clicking till you find the folder you want to keep it in.

**2d Left** click on that folder, then left click on 'save'. **Note:** you can keep its name or call it what you will.
